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## **2. Mechanism of feedback in the Institute**

The purpose of taking feedback from all the stakeholders is to improve the functioning of the institution. Though the Guru Nanak College Killianwali family does its best at all levels yet we strongly believe that there is always scope for further improvements. With an objective to make an assessment of the teaching-learning process, evaluation system, student support services and other facilities provided to students, feedback proformas are given to them to gather feedback on various aspects of the institution. This feedback proforma comprises four questionnaires based on their feedback on (i) Course (ii) Teachers (iii) Overall evaluation of Programme and Teaching (iv) Overall rating. After getting feedback proformas back, analysis is made on the basis of inputs provided by them. This feedback is analysed, discussed with the staff members and corrective steps are applied wherever required. The findings are quite positive till date as majority of the students appreciate the overall functioning of the institution. Besides the positive outcomes of teaching-learning process, they give positive remarks to the fair evaluation system. They are satisfied with the support services like library facilities, co-curricular activities, interaction with faculty members and administration as and when needed. Majority of them have expressed that they are not only intellectually enriched rather they find themselves fully equipped and empowered to face the challenges of life. Formal as well as informal feedback is gathered from other stakeholders as well. Formal Feedback from Teachers, Parents and Alumni is gathered through structured questionnaires. Informal Feedback from the Teachers and Employers is also gathered during the meetings from time to time, from Alumni the feedback is gathered during their visits to college in functions like Prize distribution, Convocation etc. There are certain students on rolls whose parents are the Alumni of the college. This clearly reflects their trust in the college – the best in the area. Informal feedback is gathered from the parents also either they are invited to attend the college events or when they are contacted personally to discuss the performance of their ward. The feedback obtained from all stakeholders is being analysed and utilized for the overall development of the institution. On the basis of such feedback and suggestions, continuous improvements are made in the institution. The valuable opinions of all the stakeholders are considered and implemented as and when it is feasible for the organisation. Keeping such suggestions in view we are planning to start some new courses from the coming sessions. Every best decision is taken which provides maximum benefit to the society. Hence, at the overall evaluation of the feedback system, it can be said that feedback is a powerful tool that actually gives us direction to move ahead in the right manner.

Proceedings

This was the last meeting of this session. In connection with the first agenda of Admission Process, free coaching classes of New Students (10+2 passout) were conducted from 6th July to 31st July 2021. 50 small banners had been created in different areas of Punjab & Haryana for the advertisement of college. 10 Students from Arts and Commerce have been benefited the Early Bird Concession of Rs. 1000/- while registering themselves as early as possible. It was suggested by the staff members that repeated efforts like phone calls should be done for admission purposes. Even the personal links should be utilized for our own institute. It was also suggested





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by the Principal sir that a Notice regarding the Online classes should be uploaded through telegram and different Whatsapp groups. An advertisement of the admission of B.A./B.Com should be given in 'Daku Ki Da' newspaper or website etc. Even the E-banner should be displayed on website, twitter, Facebook etc.

It was suggested by Principal sir that Self Study Report of NAAC should be uploaded as soon as possible. He further suggested that after doing modifications by NAAC members in 10 or 15 days, it should be submitted or uploaded as early as possible.

It is yet to decide whether the online/off line mode of teaching will be possible in the coming session. This will be possible as per the directions given by Panjab Government and Panjab University Chandigarh.

There there was a suggestion that from now onwards Mentors should be appointed for Arts department. There would be one mentor for 25 students which would have all responsibility of those 25 students. Dept. of Commerce will assign the duties of mentors as usual.

Research Committee has discussed the published work of staff members. Near about 20 papers published in U.G.C. Case list journals, Chapter in edited book, E-Conferences



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proceedings, Peer reviewed journals and Scopus Indexed International Journals through E-mail id gnc\_research1956@gmail.com upto 30th June 2021.

Then the matter of feed-back was discussed in the meeting that the Advisory Committee has already circulated the feedback (on line) forms to the students, parents, Alumni and teachers for the session 2020-21. Student Satisfaction survey form was also circulated online. As the information collected through feedback is confidential so, only the Principal Sir can check the feedback & act accordingly in next meeting if there is some induction for required for the teachers on the basis of this feedback.

As the Admission process is going to start from 9th August, so it was decided in the meeting that every teacher would prepare the Teaching plan of their respective subjects. All the staff members were directed to inform the students coming for admission about the program outcomes & course outcomes which are available on the college website for ready reference.

It was also decided in the meeting that awareness about Women Cell / Internal Complaints Committee should be given to the new students so that they can submit their complaints (if any) on line or off line through college prospectus and even by displaying the information related to GCC/Women Cell at college Notice-Board.





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At last a new point related to real life experience of academics by students was discussed and it was finalized to have one day in every week for one class to have experiential learning only on that day by one teacher only and there was a suggestion to display the list of committees on the college Notice Board for the information of all.
